

Video Camera Scavenger Hunt
OMS Video Production
Stay off the grass

Directions: Each person in your group can choose any FIVE shots from the list below. No repeats within the group. This activity will help us work on our video camera basics and eventually editing. You will be graded on the quality of your shots and the final edited product. Good luck!

Tips:

- be creative, rule of thirds
- look for other ways something can be seen
- use a tripod when you can
- record only what you need (no garbage)
- shoot to edit, leave room in front and back of each shot (pre-roll, post-roll)
- no shots longer than 25 seconds
- work together and share the camera
- have fun and represent the OMS Video Production classes

REMEMBER that you will have a news anchor in the left of each shot.

1. **CANTED** shot from a **LOW ANGLE**.
2. **XLS** of the decorated house or houses.
3. **CU** of a Prop.
4. **CU** of a Prop.
5. **CU** of a trees
6. Pick an angle, **EW** then
7. Make it a smaller shot. **LS**
8. Make it a **XCU** or **CU**
9. Do a **zoom out** from a **CU** to a **WS** (keep it steady).
10. **Worms Eye** of the Scary House
11. Shoot a good **WS** of the House
12. Shoot an **extreme LA** of someone outside. Adjust the camera so you can see the person.
13. Shoot a **HA** of someone or something. Make them look smaller than they really are.
14. Hold the camera steady with your hands (brace yourself) and **zoom** all the way in on a subject far away. Try to keep the shot as steady as possible for at least 5 seconds. If you can't do it, practice until you can!
15. **POV** Running down the sidewalk.
