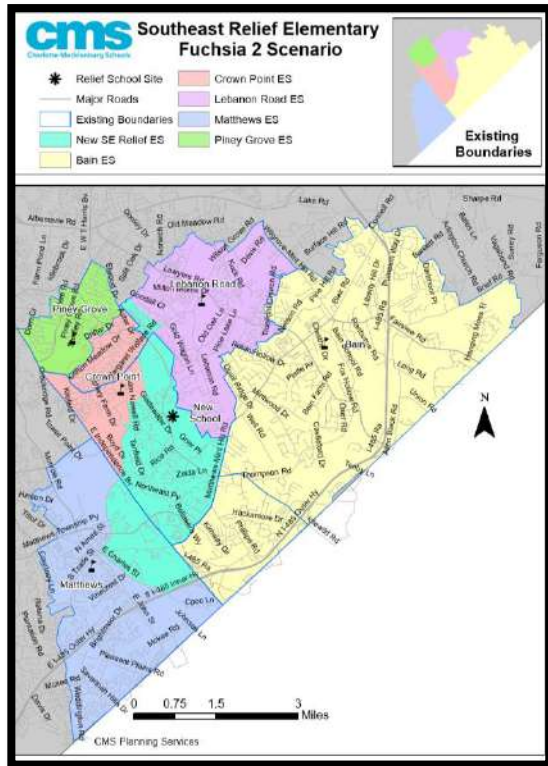


At the start of the 2022-23 school year, CMS will open a new elementary school which will provide relief for Lebanon Road, Piney Grove, Crown Point and Matthews elementary schools. Some families in each of these schools will experience a change in assignment beginning with the 2022-23 school year. The new elementary school is located at 11615 Idlewild Road Matthews, NC 28105 (on existing Mint Hill Middle School campus). The Board will vote on the new school's attendance area in late October 2021. The Office of Student Assignment and School Choice seeks your feedback on each of two draft boundary scenarios below.

Fuchsia 2 Scenario



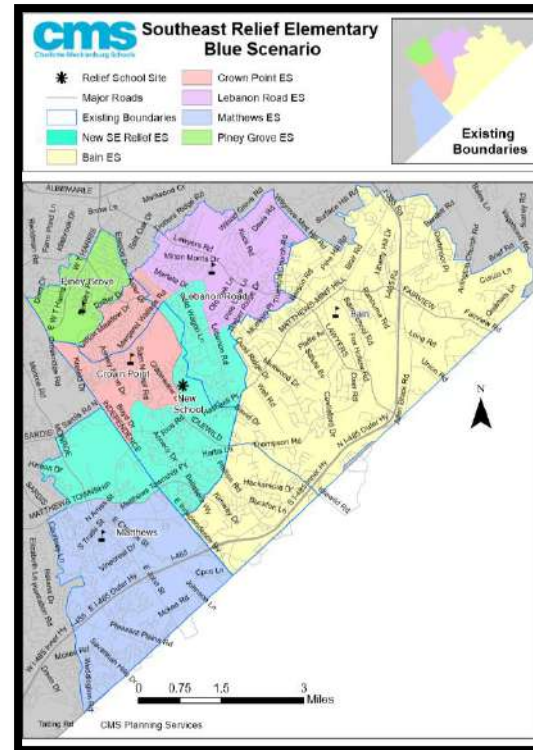
Assigns to the New Relief Elementary

- Lebanon Road ES: apartments off Margaret Wallace Rd.
- Crown Point ES: south of Sam Newell Rd. and Irvins Creek & east of Treeside Lane
- Matthews ES: south of Sam Newell Rd/ N Trade St & east of E. Charles St & north of I-485

Assigns to Crown Point

- Piney Grove ES: section that continues to Mint Hill MS

Blue Scenario



Assigns to the New Relief Elementary

- Crown Point ES: south of Sam Newell Rd. and Irvins Creek & east of Idlewild Rd.
- Matthews ES: south of Sardis Road and north of Hwy 51

Assigns to Crown Point

- Piney Grove ES: section that continues to Mint Hill MS
- Lebanon Road ES: apartments off Margaret Wallace Rd.
