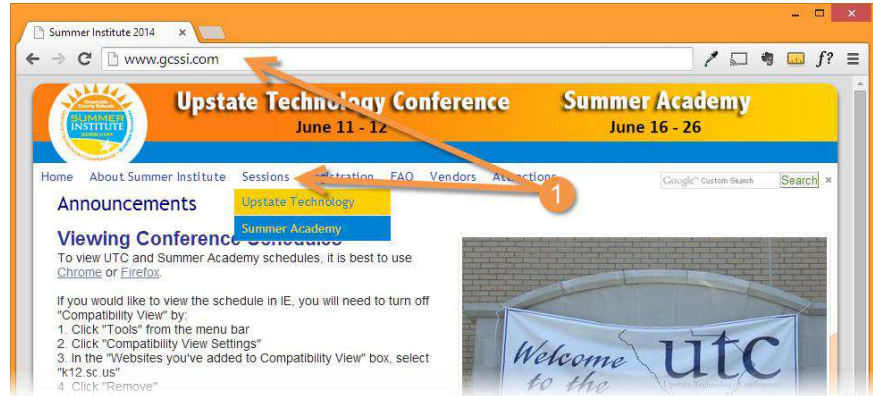




SCHED APP TUTORIALS

Signing up or logging in to the Sched App

1. Navigate to www.gcssi.com and select the "Sessions" tab and choose which conference you are attending (UTC or Summer Academy)



2. Click "Sign Up" if you have not created an account yet

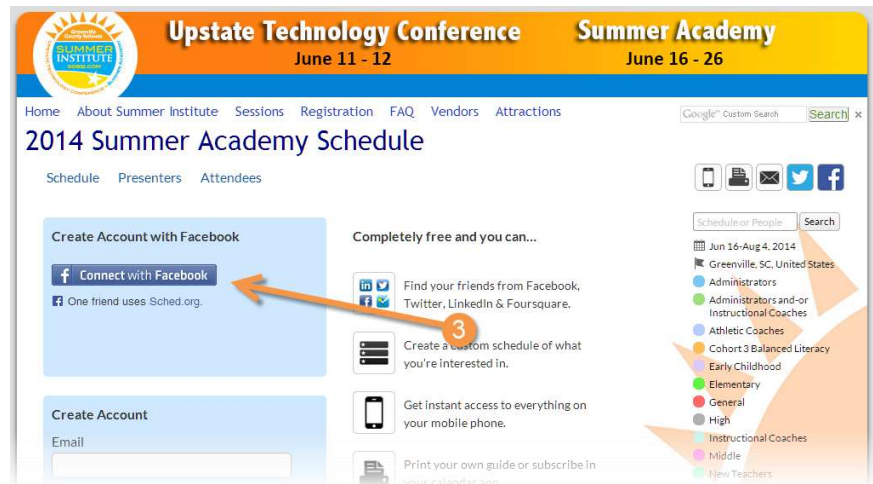
or
