Fort Gibson National Honor Society Scholarship

The Fort Gibson National Honor Society will provide as many \$500 nonrenewable scholarships as funds allow to a 2016 - 2017 Fort Gibson High School Senior. This senior must be a member of the Fort Gibson Chapter of the National Honor Society. The scholarship must be used only for education related expenses such as tuition, fees, room, board, books supplies, or travel expenses.

This scholarship will be awarded on the basis of outstanding scholarship, character, leadership, achievements, activities, and service. The winner/s will be selected on the basis of ALL qualities. Financial need is not a requirement. Only members of NHS for one complete school year are eligible. Students must have turned in all of their service points for the school year. Students with a warning for the current school year are not eligible for the scholarship.

Applicants must return a complete print **SCHOLARSHIP QUESTIONNAIRE** (it is not necessary to print this page) with all the attachments by **noon, March 24, 2017** *to the library*. Materials will NOT be accepted after the deadline. The National Honor Society Faculty Council will select the winner/s; their decision will be final.

The scholarship winner/s will be notified at the National Honor Society Banquet, April 17, 2017. Before the scholarship is awarded, the National Honor Society Advisers must have verification of college admission. Scholarships may not be held for students more than two years between high school graduation and entering college.

Plan ahead:

- Make a second copy of the Questionnaire, just in case the computer fails.
- If the Character Section of the form asks for a letter recommending you. Ask them at least a week ahead of time. Tell them you need the letters a day or two before the deadline.
- Start gathering the information in the Questionnaire as soon as you have it. Ask your parents to help. Go through your closet or scrapbook for awards or honors certificates.
- Ask the High School Registrar, for a transcript at least 3 school days before the deadline.
- Put your information together in final form, following all instructions at least 3 school days before the deadline.
- Ask for signatures on p. 6 a day or two ahead of the deadline. Someone may be gone or busy at the last moment. Your emergency does not constitute an emergency for everyone else. Be thoughtful and considerate.
- Make sure you have 20 total NHS service points, 3 meetings attended and 4 service points for an NHS fund raiser or service project.
