The Steps In Opportunity Tech Award was created in response to a need in our Thurston County community. The importance of education along with the rising costs associated with women achieving their goals were some of the factors considered in the creation of this award. This award is available to all female-identifying individuals who find themselves in need of financial assistance for a piece of technology to complete their education. This is a competitive process.

An award will be presented to a female-identifying applicant who is 16-21 years of age with demonstrated financial need in pursuit of their future educational goals. The maximum value of the award is \$500 and will be used to assist with the purchase of the recipient's technology needs. Once selected, the recipient will choose their technology, and our club will purchase it directly – or reimburse the recipient after purchase – within the award amount.

This award includes, but is not limited to, applicants who are in their final stages of completing or pursuing their high school diploma, diploma equivalency, or GED and/or are pursuing or plan to pursue a vocational certificate, technical certificate, or various undergraduate degrees – i.e., associates or bachelor's degrees.
