The School-Based Health Center provides:

- Care and treatment for illness
- Athletic physicals and well-child exams
- Check-ups and annual exams
- Dental exams and cleanings
- Vision exams and glasses
- Mental health counseling
- Free pharmacy delivery
- Physicals and immunizations for:
 - Preschool
 - Kindergarten
 - 7th grade
 - 12th grade

Parents must complete the lifetime consent form for each student.

This allows Five Rivers Health Centers to treat your child during the school day. This is necessary to receive care but only needs to be filled out once while the student attends Dayton Public Schools.

DPS students will be transported from their school to the school-based health center for care during the school day.
