- 1) Every student graduates with meaningful employment or higher education opportunities.
- 2) Every student has access to a rich, diverse and rigorous curriculum.
- 3) Every student has access to more social and emotional supports.

2020-2021 School Improvement Plan Goals

- 1) 95% of enrolled Levine Middle College High School students will earn a C or above on the NCFE's during the 2020-2021 school year. (2.04) **Fall, 2019 Results: 98.5% tested students scored a C or higher on the NCFE's. No spring results due to COVID 19.**
- 2) 100% of Levine Middle College High School 11th grade students will earn a cumulative Central Piedmont Community College GPA of 2.0 or higher for the 2020-2021 school year. (3.06) **2019-2020 Final Results: 11th grade students earned an average 2.931 CPCC GPA for fall and spring CPCC classes. 78% earned a 2.0 CPCC GPA or above. 22% earned below a 2.0 GPA.**
- 3) Levine Middle College High School students will earn an average GPA of 3.0 or above in their Central Piedmont Community College classes during the 2020-2021 school year. (4.06) **Final Results: All students earned an average GPA in all 2019-2020 CPCC classes of 2.916.**
- 4) Levine Middle College High School will provide a minimum of 30 minutes of duty free lunch period on a daily basis for every teacher. (4.06)
- 5) Levine Middle College High School will provide duty free instructional planning time for every teacher with the goal of providing an average of at least five hours of planning time per week. (A.204)
- 6) Levine Middle College High School will provide a positive school climate by promoting a safe learning environment free of bullying and harassing behaviors. (A4.06)
