The 3rd top endangered animal is the Namibia Cheetah. The Namibia cheetah lives in Namibia Africa. Fewer than 12,000 cheetahs remain world wide. Threatened by persecution by humans, loss of prey base and habitat, and competition with larger animals. These cheetahs are very rare and their numbers are dropping every day.

The 2nd top endangered animal in the world is small cat. The small cat may look friendly but is not. They are forced to protect themselves from dangerous predators. They are threatened by loss of habitat, loss of prey, indiscriminate killing, and contact with humans, livestock, and other dangerous and domestic animals. There are very few left in existence and more are getting poached every day for their fur.

The 1st top endangered animal in the world is the Ethiopian wolf. There are only 500 left in existence and fewer every day. They are threatened by humans and domestic animals. They are the only wolf in Africa and every day we get closer to no wolves at all in Africa.
