ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Norwood High School provides a comprehensive education that is geared toward college and career readiness. Students take a core curriculum that includes the following (along with years required to meet graduation requirements):

English	4 years
Math	4 years
Science	3 years
Social Studies	3 years
PE/Health	4 years

Note: Foreign Language is not a graduation requirement but students typically take a minimum of 2 years; 3-4 years is recommended.

Students must also meet the Competency Determination for the MCAS exams in ELA, Math, & Science (passing score = 220)
