School:

Established in 1883, Gettysburg Area High School is a comprehensive public high school with a student body of 1,000 in grades 9-12. The school employs approximately eighty certified faculty members and more than 60% of those hold advanced degrees. We have 1 Principal, 2 Assistant Principals, 3 School Counselors, 1 School Nurse, 1 Librarian and 1 Athletic Director. Our student support staff consists of a school Psychologist, Social Worker, Family Navigator, Speech Therapist, an English as a Second Language program and Learning Support classes.

Opportunities:

Area Colleges and Community College also provide opportunities for students to take college level courses during their senior year.

College level courses taken outside high school and taught by teachers not employed by GASD, independent study, foreign exchange student work and transferring grades from other high schools will receive credit for work but will not be included in GPA for class rank calculations.

Curriculum:

Students have over 100 required and elective courses to choose from. GAHS is on block scheduling by semester. Classes are required in English, Social Studies, Math, Science, PE, Health, Personal Finance, Freshman FACS, Safety Ed, Careers & Research. Other offered programs include Agriculture, Art, Business, Career and Technology, Foreign Languages, Family and Consumer Science, Music, Technical Education, JROTC, and career internships. There is a comprehensive interscholastic athletic program for both boys and girls in thirteen sports.
