

How to distribute to your students if they have Google Drive.

- Once you have copied your file, it will open. When you want to share the file with students, click the <u>Share button</u> in the upper right-hand corner of your screen.
- A box opens asking you to share with others. Make sure you set it to <u>Can view</u> so that students can't edit your original copy. Then click <u>Get shareable link</u>. Distribute this link to your students.
- Once students are notified of the new document, they will find it in their Google Drive. When they click on <u>Shared with me</u> they will find the document.
- 4. When they open the document, they will need to go to <u>File</u> and click on <u>Make a copy</u>. This way they can have an editable copy for themselves in their own drive, otherwise they will not be able to type in the text boxes.
