

Student Qualifications for Nomination to the SNHS

Membership for a student in the SNHS is conferred as a rising junior or senior in high school. A student must have and maintain a 3.0 unweighted grade point average (4.0 scale) to be a member. In addition, the following qualifications must be met and maintained:

- A member must be enrolled in at least one honors or upper level science class during or prior to the eleventh grade year.
- A member must be enrolled in at least one second year honors or upper level science class during or prior to the twelfth grade year.
- A member must maintain a B+ average (3.5 on a 4.0 scale) across all science courses.

If you are applying as an eleventh grader, you must have taken or be enrolled in an honors or upper level science class. If you are applying as a twelfth grader, you must be in your second year of an honors or upper level science class.
