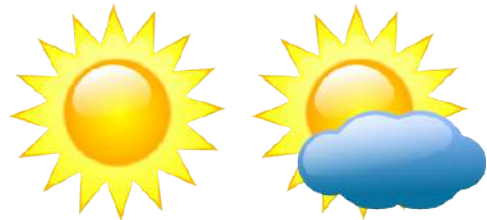

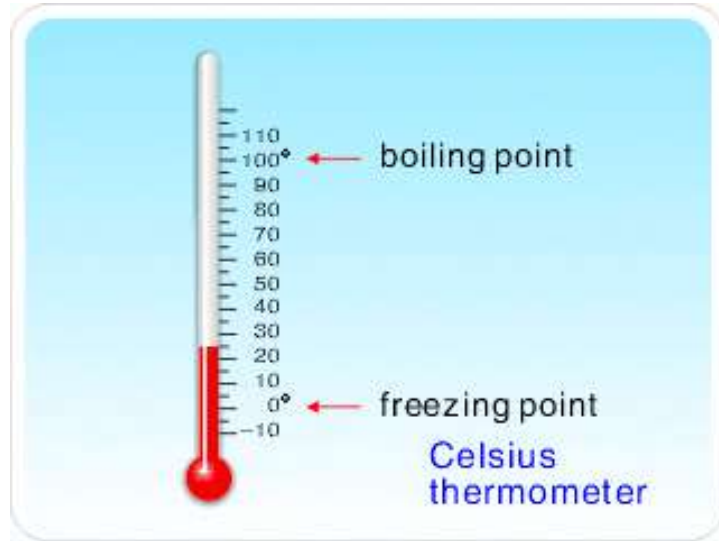


What is a blizzard?

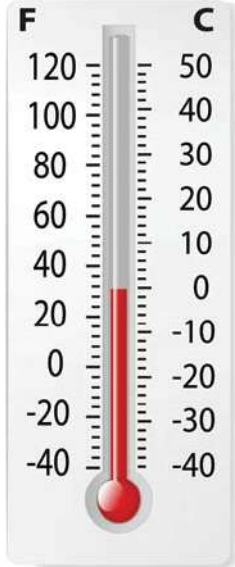


What are floods?

A meteorologist studies the weather and uses satellites and computers to predict the weather.

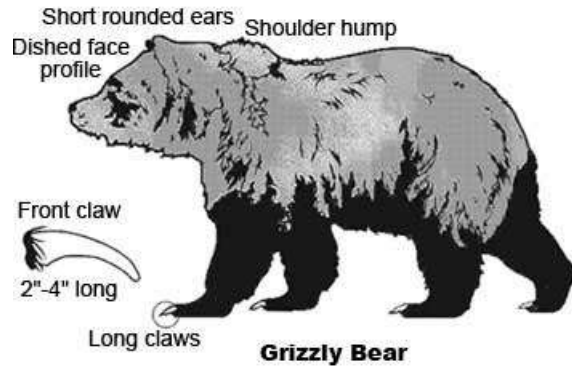

Winter, spring, summer, and fall is the cycle of the seasons.

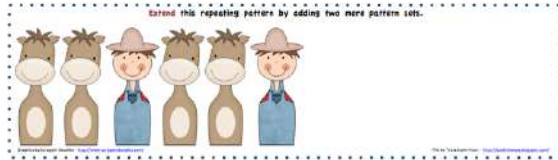
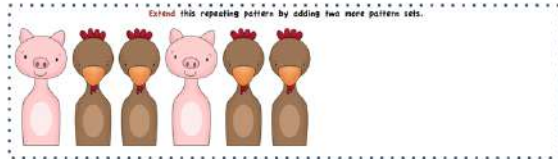
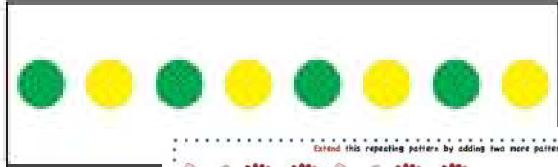
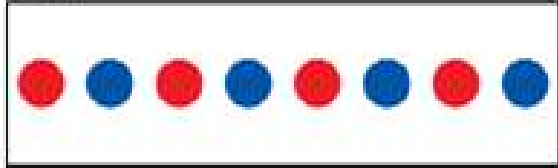
