

Wednesday, June 13 -

EARLY DISMISSAL FOR SENIORS at 12:35 p.m.

- Preliminary graduation rehearsal in the auditorium at 7:40 a.m.
 Morning bus pick up will be provided.
 <u>Bus transportation will not be available at dismissal.</u>
- Outdoor senior luncheon will be provided (bring yearbooks for signing).
- Caps & Gowns will be distributed. Go to the posted letter of the alphabet that begins your last name. There you will be given a bag containing cap, gown, tassel, and a collar for the girls. Those students ranking in the upper 10% of the class will exchange the tassel in their bags for a gold honors tassel. The names of these students appear at the end of this bulletin. It is the student's responsibility to obtain his/her honors tassel. The exchange can be done at the time the student picks up their cap & gown.

<u>MANDATORY</u> COMMENCEMENT REHEARSAL FOR SENIORS IN THE HIGH SCHOOL AUDITORIUM – 7:40 A.M. Prior to leaving, seniors will be given their guest tickets and then are dismissed for the remainder of the afternoon. *Bus Transportation will not be available.*

- 1. Rehearsal is scheduled to begin at 7:40 a.m. sharp on Wednesday, June 13. All seniors will report to the auditorium at this time. Since important instructions will be given, it is necessary that seniors be punctual. NO STUDENT MAY PARTICIPATE IN COMMENCEMENT WHO HAS NOT ATTENDED REHEARSAL.
- 2. If you need additional tickets, please send a <u>written</u> note to Mr. Berrios' office with the name and relationship to the graduate for whom the additional tickets are needed and we will do our best to accommodate all reasonable requests. Stadium tickets are limited, so please be mindful of this when making your request. Additional tickets for the hillside above the stadium are available for extended family members. All tickets will be distributed to the seniors following graduation practice on June 13.

- 1. Guests will not be permitted on the stadium field until the end of Commencement. <u>Balloons, chairs and coolers are not permitted in the stadium.</u>

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION REGARDING COMMENCEMENT

- 1. The names of scholarship recipients will be published at graduation. These students will receive an envelope containing information about the scholarship after graduation in Cafeteria A when they pick up their diploma.
- 2. <u>PARTICIPATION IN COMMENCEMENT IS VOLUNTARY.</u> HOWEVER, IF STUDENTS DO CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE, CERTAIN STANDARDS OF DRESS AND BEHAVIOR ARE EXPECTED. YOUR COOPERATION IN THIS MATTER OF SETTING THE PROPER FORMAL TONE FOR THESE CEREMONIES WILL BE APPRECIATED.
- 3. All young women will need two safety pins for the collars that must be attached to their gowns. Please pin this collar on the gown before leaving home. Also, all young women should wear light-colored dresses under their gowns and appropriate and comfortable dress shoes, keeping in mind that the processional will be a long walk from the auditorium to Schwarzman Stadium.
- 4. Young men should wear neckties and light-colored shirts under their gowns. Regular dark dress trousers and shoes should be worn. Shorts are **NOT** appropriate attire for this occasion.
- 5. All seniors must report to the senior high school auditorium at 5:45 p.m. Appropriate attire will be checked before admission to the auditorium is granted. Any student who attempts to bring any inappropriate objects into the stadium or any student who is inappropriately attired will be denied participation in the graduation ceremony. This policy will be strictly monitored and enforced before the students begin their procession into the stadium.

OBLIGATIONS / DISCIPLINE

- 1. Only the diploma cover will be issued during the ceremony. Diplomas will be given to the students after graduation in Cafeteria A pending appropriate participation in graduation exercises. Therefore, the following should be read carefully and strictly observed.
 - a. Any student who disrupts the graduation ceremony will face disciplinary consequences, up to and including expulsion & removal from the graduation ceremony. All school rules will be in effect, including but not limited to policies on drugs and drug paraphernalia, alcohol, smoking, controlled substances, inhalants, violence, obscene conduct, disruption, or an act deemed to be a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of any member of the school community.
 - b. All obligations such as B lunches, library fines and books, uniforms, gym locks, and any other debts must be cleared before a diploma will be granted. These items should be taken care of prior to picking up your cap and gown on Tuesday, June 12.
 - c. Detentions, incomplete work, all exams, and other assignments must be cleared by dismissal on Monday, June 11.
 - d. The responsibility for clearing all obligations rests with the student. **DO NOT WAIT FOR THE**TEACHER TO CONTACT YOU.
 - e. PARTICIPANTS MUST BE PRESENT FOR ALL REHEARSALS AND ARE TO BE PROMPT AND COOPERATIVE.

After Monday, June 11, seniors should refrain from wandering through the building since junior and sophomore classes will still be in session.

Seniors who will not be graduating must attend all assigned Grade 10 and 11 classes and exams still in session.
