Tuesday, June 7

- Preliminary MANDATORY Graduation Rehearsal in the auditorium at 7:35 a.m. Morning bus pick up will be provided. School district transportation will not be available at dismissal.
- Caps & Gowns will be distributed in Cafeteria B. Go to the posted letter of the alphabet that begins your last name. There you will receive a bag containing a cap, gown, tassel, and a collar (if applicable). Those students ranking in the upper 10% of the class should also obtain a gold honors tassel in Cafeteria B. The gold tassel will be available to pick up in Cafeteria B and will not be included in the cap/gown bag. The names of these students appear at the end of this bulletin. It is the student's responsibility to obtain their honors tassel.
- NHS Students can pick up their gold sashes at cap/gown distribution. NHS students are obligated to pay dues from both 11th and 12th grades (\$15 for each year). The cost of the gold sash is \$25; students can return their gold sashes at the conclusion of graduation and get their \$25 back. See Mrs. Chakler or Mr. Vorchheimer in the College and Career Center with any questions.
- Grad Walk will occur for seniors who signed up and submitted their signed parent permission forms. Grad Walk participants will be able to pick-up their cap and gown at 8:30 a.m. on June 7, 2022 in Cafeteria B. Buses will depart from the Senior High School at 10:00 a.m. Buses should return to Abington Senior High School from the elementary schools at 11:00 a.m. In the event of inclement weather, the event may be canceled.
- Outdoor senior bbq will be provided (bring yearbooks for signing). The barbecue will occur after the rehearsal and will be held on the field between the main entrance and the tennis courts.
- CHROMEBOOK AND CHARGER COLLECTIONS Members of the technology department will be in the Auditorium lobby to take your chromebook and charger. Textbooks and other school materials will also be collected by the faculty in the Auditorium lobby.

- MANDATORY COMMENCEMENT REHEARSAL FOR SENIORS IN THE HIGH SCHOOL AUDITORIUM – 7:45 A.M. All students will report to the auditorium at this time. NO STUDENT MAY PARTICIPATE IN COMMENCEMENT WHO HAS NOT ATTENDED THIS REHEARSAL. Prior to leaving, seniors will be given their guest tickets and then are dismissed for the remainder of the afternoon. <u>Bus</u> transportation will not be available at dismissal.
- Schwarzman Stadium has handicapped seating available for all individuals who
 require it. Handicapped seating cannot be reserved. Handicapped parking is
 available on campus. If you submit an email to <u>jodihaasz@abington.k12.pa.us</u>, a
 placard will be placed with your graduate's tickets given to the student at rehearsal.

COMMENCEMENT SPECTATORS

- Guests will not be permitted on the stadium field until the end of Commencement.
 <u>Balloons, chairs and coolers are not permitted in the stadium.</u>
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere on school district property.
- Pets are not permitted anywhere on school district property.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION REGARDING COMMENCEMENT

- All seniors must report to the senior high school auditorium at 5:45 p.m. Appropriate attire will be checked before admission to the auditorium is granted. Any student who attempts to bring any inappropriate objects into the stadium or any student who is inappropriately attired will be denied participation in the graduation ceremony. This policy will be strictly monitored and enforced before the students begin their procession into the stadium.
- 2. Only the diploma cover will be issued during the ceremony. Diplomas will be given to the students after graduation in Cafeteria A, pending appropriate participation in graduation exercises. Therefore, the following should be read carefully and strictly observed.
- 3. The ceremony will be live streamed. 2022 Commencement Live Stream

OBLIGATIONS / DISCIPLINE

- a. Any student who disrupts the graduation ceremony will face disciplinary consequences, up to and including expulsion & removal from the graduation ceremony. All school rules will be in effect, including but not limited to policies on drugs and drug paraphernalia, alcohol, smoking, controlled substances, inhalants, violence, obscene conduct, disruption, or an act deemed to be a threat to the health, safety, and welfare of any member of the school community.
- b. All obligations must be cleared before a diploma will be granted.
- c. Incomplete work, all exams, and other assignments must be cleared by dismissal on Thursday, June 2.
- d. The responsibility for clearing all obligations rests with the student. **DO NOT WAIT FOR THE TEACHER TO CONTACT YOU.**

After Thursday, June 2, seniors should refrain from wandering through the building since junior and sophomore classes will still be in session.

Seniors who will not be graduating must attend all assigned Grade 10 and 11 classes and exams still in session.
