All students entering 12th grade must have two doses of the Meningococcal vaccine. The State of Ohio requires that all students must have these immunizations. Please have your physician or health department complete the needed immunization and return the record to the school. If your son/daughter has already received these, please send a copy of the immunization record to the school office so their record can be properly updated.

Children who are not in compliance will be excluded from school after October 1st, per state law.

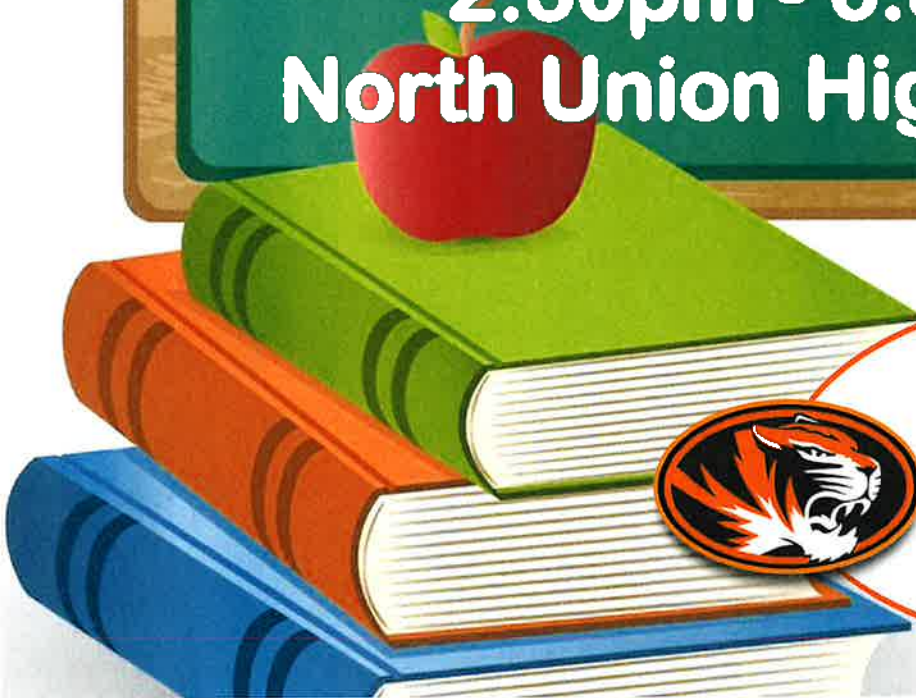
