FAFSA is the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, which needs to be completed in order to apply for aid such as federal grants, work study, and loans. In addition, many states and colleges use your FAFSA information to determine your eligibility for state and school aid, **so it is important to fill this out even if you don't think your income level will qualify for federal grants.**
