- 1. What are your academic interests? Which courses have you enjoyed the most and why?
- 2. What college major(s) are you giving serious consideration to pursuing at this time? What do you hope to accomplish in college and thereafter? What do you believe are your career goals?
- 3. What activities have you participated in school that have been the most meaningful and what have you learned from these activities? Consider artistic, athletic, community service, and especially <u>leadership</u> positions. Is this something you would like to continue at the college level?
- 4. How have you grown over four years as a learner, student and personally? How have you demonstrated leadership or initiatives within a classroom setting or within the community? How has your role changed within the school community and at home?
- 5. Have you ever demonstrated a willingness to take risks and go beyond the normal classroom experience? If so tell me in detail about it and if not, explain why not?
- 6. What do you consider your most admirable qualities? List at least <u>3</u> and explain each in several sentences, and in detail how you have exhibited these qualities?
- 7. Do you have any "hidden" extracurricular talents/hobbies or interests that are not affiliated with school-based organizations or clubs?
- 8. Share a significant experience, obstacle, or challenge you overcame, and what did you learn about yourself? (Please provide specific anecdotes.)
- 9. Have any unusual situations or specific experiences (family issues, illness, moving, etc.) had an impact on your life either academically or personally? How has the experience shaped who you are today?
- 10. What are you passionate about? What inspires or motivates you when no one is looking and what makes you thrive?
- 11. What makes you unique? Choose at least three or four adjectives that best describe you and provide an example where you have exhibited these qualities. Please be as specific as you can.
- 12. What quote, motto or creed best describes you or your philosophy of life and why?
- 13. What do you consider your greatest strengths? And what are your weaknesses or 'blind-spots"? What areas can you improve on and how would you go about doing this?
- 14. Self-Reflective Question- Imagine that you are an Admissions Counselor reading your application.
