
There is still time to sign up for Globetrotters Geography Club. It meets every Wednesday from 2:50 - 4:00 pm until October 13th.

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Welcome back to the KASD Libraries!

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to school! We are so happy to invite your child into our school library. During library visits, students are provided with an opening read aloud, book talks, or instructional activity and then they are able to browse the library. Students can have up to 5 materials checked out at a time. Younger students will be encouraged to borrow a book or two at a time, and all students will be stopped when they reach five items. Each item is loaned for 2 weeks, with the opportunity to renew. We do not have any overdue fines, but returning books in a timely manner allows all students the opportunity to use the materials.

Students can also utilize our online library at destinydiscover.com. Here, students can check to see if the library owns specific titles, check the status of their library account, and place holds on books. Additionally, destinydiscover.com hosts a wide selection of e-books that students can access from anywhere 24/7!

You can help your child's school library experience by:

- Talking with your child about what books they are selecting
- Finding a safe place in the child's home(s) where the library book will be out of reach of the family pet(s) and younger siblings
- Reminding your child to return their books on their library day
- Enjoying books with your child. Notice pictures, read text aloud, and share thoughts and feelings about the text.
- Encouraging varied reading activities and exposures, including fiction, non-fiction, magazines, audio, etc.
- Letting your child see you reading for pleasure.

If a book is ever damaged at home, please just send it back to school with a note. No fines or fees will be charged. If a book is ever lost at home, please let your child's teacher or the school librarian know. We do not ask for replacement fees, but we do ask that you return the book if it is ever located.



INFORMATION For Parents



IF YOUR FAMILY LIVES IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

In a shelter

In a motel or campground due to the lack of an alternative adequate accommodation

*

In a car, park, abandoned building, or bus or train station

Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship

Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

Your eligible children have the right to:

- Receive a free, appropriate public education.
- Enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment.
- Enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents.
- Enroll in the local school; or continue attending their school of origin (the school they attended when permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), if that is your preference.
 - * If the school district believes that the school you select is not in the best interest of your children, then the district must provide you with a written explanation of its position and inform you of your right to appeal its decision.
- Receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if you request this.
- Receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to your children's needs.

If you believe your children may be eligible, contact the local liaison to find out what services and supports may be available. There also may be supports available for your preschool-age children.
