### **Secure Vestibule Update**:

We also want to thank you all for your support last year as we rolled out "Raptor," the new Visitor and Volunteer information check-in system. You have been so kind in bringing in your driver licenses (or other government IDs if you do not have a license) to get scanned. The routine will continue this year as well and you will still need to come in each time to scan your license in the system to generate your visitor/volunteer badge; this process will get you access into the school. Please make it a habit to bring your ID in each time. If you are just coming to drop something off or waiting in the office to pick a child up, you don't need to scan in.

In late October or early November, a new secure vestibule (locked enclosed entry) will be installed at our school. The construction process will take approximately 5-7 weeks. The construction crew will work outside of school hours during this process. All elementary schools in Bend-La Pine are getting the new vestibules, which will add another layer of security to our buildings.

#### **BUS TRANSPORTATION NEWS:**

New this year, Bend-La Pine Schools families will be able to opt into a system that will allow them track when their child enters and exits the school bus with the new Radio Frequency Identification Device cards (RFID).

Participating students will receive a unique card embedded with a chip. Students will scan their RFID cards when entering and exiting the bus. The scanner will log the location and time of entries or exits. Parents can view this data using the MyStop app available for download on the Bend-La Pine Schools website.

Interested parents or guardians can fill out the RFID consent form, available at our website. Upon completion, parents can drop off the form with the Transportation Department between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. (501 SE Second St. in Bend or 16350 First St. in La Pine) or at the school office.

Bend LaPine Schools Nutrition Services Applications for 2018-19 school year are available online at https://www.bend.k12.or.us/district/parents/school-meals or at the front desk.

Students will <u>need to qualify to receive the no cost <u>lunch</u> <u>benefit</u>. To see if your child qualifies for <u>lunch</u> at no cost, you will need to do one of the following:</u>

- Submit an application with your household income
- Submit an application with your SNAP or TANF information
- Submit an application indicating that your student is a Foster Child

If your child does not qualify for lunches at no cost you may purchase the meals for only \$2.75 each.

No cost breakfast will continue to be available to all students.
