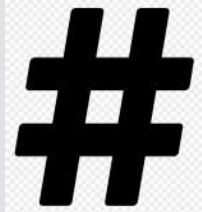

My name is Maeve O'Donnell and I'm so excited to be the new Learning Facilitator at Ebenezer! This is my fifth year of employment with the district, and I previously split my time between the four elementary buildings as a school psychologist. I'm looking forward to providing daily support to the students, teachers, and families of Ebenezer Elementary.

A variety of school guidance services are provided to students, including the following:

Classroom guidance lessons. I will be conducting classroom guidance lessons in grades K-5 to address social-emotional skills, academics skills, and careers.

The following are the topics of the guidance lessons:

Kindergarten—Identify Feelings, Cooperate with Others, and Show Respectful Behaviors

First—Friendship Skills and Conflict Resolution

Second—Becoming a Successful Learner & Personal Safety

Third—Bullying Prevention and Conflict Resolution

Fourth—Identify Sparks/Interests/Abilities; Explore Career Awareness

Fifth—Exploring Career Development and Career Awareness

Small group counseling. I facilitate small group counseling throughout the school year and include such topics as social skills, anger management, anxiety coping strategies, and study skills.

Individual counseling. At the request of parents, I meet with students who have ongoing difficulties and need extra support in the school setting.

Consultation with teachers and parents. There are times when a team is needed to problem-solve and devise strategies and approaches to help children succeed.

When I'm not at work, you can find me with my husband and 1-year-old daughter, Erin. We are having so much fun watching her grow!

From the Desk of Ms. Lu, Certified School Nurse:

- ✓ Parents of **kindergarten** students: Please RETURN the **private physical and private dental forms** to the nurse's office **ASAP**. Parents requesting a school physical or dental exam for their kindergarten child will be notified when they are scheduled. Physical and dental forms for your providers can be downloaded from the Ebenezer website.
- ✓ Parents of **third grade** students: Please RETURN the private dental form to the nurse's office **ASAP**. Parents requesting school dental exams will be notified when they are scheduled. Dental exam forms can be downloaded from the Ebenezer website.

FOOD ALLERGY NOTICE

Food allergies in children are very common. In fact, some of you may have children who are allergic to a food item. Please understand that we have students in classrooms that are severely allergic to peanuts, eggs, cow's milk, oranges, peanut butter, seafood and tree nuts. This includes walnuts, cashews, coconut and anything made with their oils. Students could have a life-threatening reaction if these foods are ingested.

For the safety of all students, please **do not** send any food treats to school without your child's teacher's approval. Thank you for your help in this important manner.

Communication with the nurse: Non-urgent information may be sent to students' parents via their home email address as noted in the school records. **Please be sure to keep your phone numbers and email address up to date with the school's main office.** Phone calls will continue to be used for all urgent information.

HEARING SCREENINGS for students in Kindergarten through third grade will be held on Friday, September 20, 2019. You will be notified if your child has a problem.

PRESCRIPTION DRUGS/

MEDICATIONS

Whenever possible, medications should be given at home. If a medication must be taken at school, please ask your pharmacist to make a second, labeled bottle for school medications.

Cornwall-Lebanon School District, following Pennsylvania Department of Health Guidelines for Administration of Medications at School, has adopted the following medication policy.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

Policy No. 210 –Use of Medications

"Before any medication may be administered to or by any student during school hours, the Board shall require the written request of the parent/guardian and the written order of the prescribing physician which shall include the purpose of the medication, dosage, the time at which or special circumstances under which the medication shall be administered, length of period for which medication is prescribed, and possible side effects of medication." For the purpose of this policy, medication shall include all medicines prescribed by a physician, including over-the-counter medications, such as Tylenol, Tums, Ibuprofen, or cough/cold medications.

Medication Consent forms are available in the nurse's office or on the Ebenezer or district website. A parent or adult designee must transport all medications to and from school, including any over-the-counter medications (Tylenol, Tums, cough/cold medications, etc.). Students may **not** transport medications to or from school unless an order to self-carry a medication is signed by a parent **and** physician.

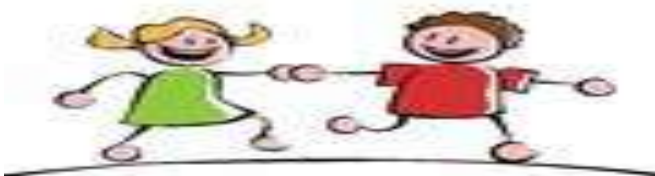
