- All teachers must teach the grade-level Title IX lesson by September 22nd.

- **Principal Updates**

- 2019-2020 Enrollment Update
 - 1325 current enrollment (100 students over projection)
 - After the 20th day of school, the district will review which schools need more teachers, and which schools have more staff than necessary. After that, we will possibly get more teachers.
 - One position we will need is 8th grade math.
 - MTS Elective is another position that we would like to have for our electives to offer additional academic support for students.
- Staffing
 - One of our new hires for 8th grade social studies was unable to fulfill the position, but we have found a new candidate.
 - There are also two Extensions assistants that are in the process of being hired currently, as well.
- Title IX SLT Compliance Training
 - Viewed the Title IX presentation from CMS and viewed the Safe Place to Learn Title IX and Sexual Harassment K12 Schools presentation
 - Any suggestions, concerns, or recommendations regarding sexual harassment of students will be discussed during at least two

meetings each semester.

- Next meeting we will share the updated Student School Climate Survey Results.
- We use a portal to document incidents and how the incident was handled in the school.
- District must have a Title IX Coordinator (Stephanie McKinney), publish a sex nondiscrimination policy, and adopt and publicize grievance procedures.
- All staff members receive training every school year and each grade level receives a lesson from a teacher about what harassment is and who they can go to for help.
- Our goal is to create a culture of respect and ensure students know they can come to us for help if they feel uncomfortable.
