Please see the attached home connections letter.</p>	<p>Math:</p> <p><b>3.NS.2</b> The student will demonstrate an understanding of the base 10 system to compare and order whole numbers up to 9,999.</p> <p><i>Students will demonstrate the following Knowledge and Skills:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) <b>Compare</b> two whole numbers, each 9,999 or less, using symbols (<math>&gt;</math>, <math>&lt;</math>, <math>=</math>, <math>\neq</math>) and/or words (<i>greater than, less than, equal to, not equal to</i>), with and without models.</li><li>b) <b>Order</b> up to three whole numbers, each 9,999 or less, represented with and without models, from least to greatest and greatest to least.</li></ul>
<p>Science:</p> <p>3.2 The student will investigate and understand that the direction and size of force affects the motion of an object. Key ideas include</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) multiple forces may act on an object;</li><li>b) the net force on an object determines how an object moves;</li><li>c) simple machines increase or change the direction of a force; and</li><li>d) simple and compound machines have many applications.</li></ul>	<p>Social Studies:</p> <p>3.6 The student will develop map skills by using globes and maps to locate and describe major rivers, mountain ranges, and other geographic features of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Africa;</li><li>b) Asia;</li><li>c) Europe;</li><li>d) North America; and</li><li>e) South America</li></ul>
