- Babies listen to and watch everything you do.
- In the first 3 years, a baby's brain grows to 80% of adult size.
- Babies' brains develop from the **loving attention** and **language** of the people around them.



What you can do . . .

- Talk* about what you and your baby are doing, seeing, feeling, touching, and smelling while it's happening.
- Talk about, name, and respect your baby's feelings.
- Respond to your baby's gestures, looks, sounds, and first words. Your baby and you can have a conversation!
- Talk with your baby in your home language.
