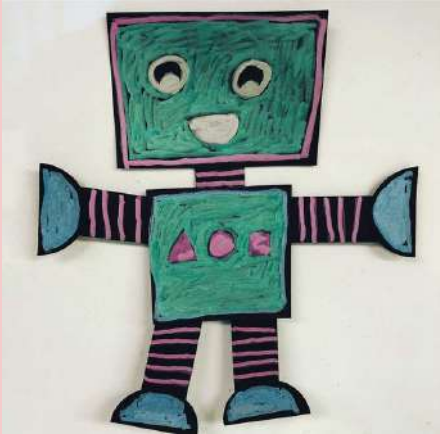

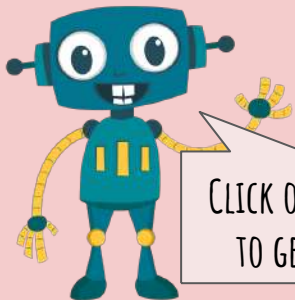
Shape Rocket Ship

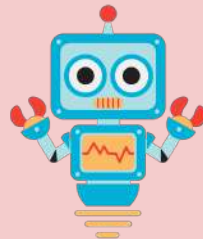
- Toilet paper roll

Robots



Materials:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Crayon or colored pencil

1. Start near the top of your paper and pick a shape for the head of your robot
1. Add more shapes to create eyes, a mouth, ears, and more!
1. Draw a large shape for the body and connect it to the head
1. Add some buttons and switches
1. Give your robot some arms and legs

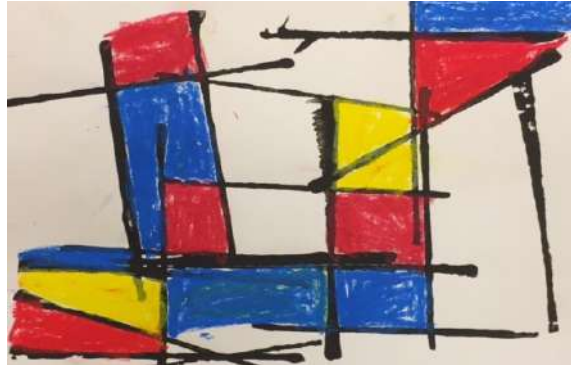
Mondrian shapes



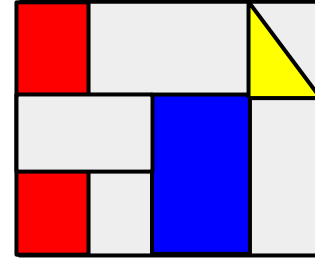
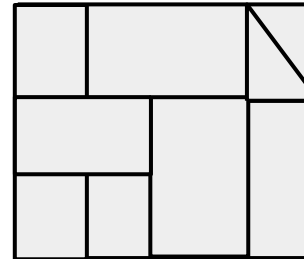
Materials:

- Paper
- Pencil
- something to color with

1. Draw lines across the entire paper making squares, rectangles, and triangles
1. Make your lines thick and dark with a marker or paint
1. Color in the shapes using only primary colors

Shape Rocket Ship

Materials:

- Toilet paper roll
- Something to color with
- Colored paper
- Scissors
- Glue

1. Color your toilet paper roll
1. Add windows
1. Decorate the rocket with other shapes
1. Cut a circle from paper
1. Fold in half 2 times
1. Cut a line into the middle, Overlap and glue
1. Attach to rocket
1. Make accordion folds (zig zag)
1. Attach to bottom of rocket
