



## **SHELBY ESTEP MEMORIAL FFA SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

### **CRITERIA**

**Purpose:** To provide a scholarship to a high school graduating senior from the Southwest FFA District of MO attending a vocational school or college/university

**Amount:** The scholarship amount is dependent upon amount available to spend (ATS).

One \$500.00 scholarship will be awarded for the 2015-16 academic year.

**Eligibility:**

1. High School Senior who is a member of a FFA chapter in one of the following counties: Taney, Christian, Lawrence, Greene, Stone, Barry, McDonald, Newton, Jasper, Hickory, Vernon, Douglas, Cedar, Barton, Dade, Polk, Webster, Laclede, Wright, and Dallas.
2. Submit both FFA and Leadership pages from the State FFA Degree Application.
3. Please write a 500-word essay that answers these questions: What have you learned through your leadership involvement in FFA, and how does this affect your future?
4. Financial need as determined by the FAFSA- EFC.
5. Due date is April 1<sup>st</sup> to address on Application

**Selection Committee:** The Selection Committee will be composed of two family members and three Agriculture teachers who do not have a student applying. The Selection Committee will be responsible for providing CFO's scholarship coordinator with the name of the recipient and application. If the Committee is not maintaining a file on all applications, all applications will be sent to CFO.

Children of the Selection Committee are not eligible for the scholarship unless that committee member resigns from the committee.

Criteria may be amended upon the recommendation of the selection committee with the approval of the Donor and the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of the Ozarks.

**Selection Calendar and Process:** Scholarship applications will be available from the CFO website [www.cfozarks.org](http://www.cfozarks.org), as well as the SW District Ag Teachers association and should be returned to the address listed on the application. Applications will be available to the Selection Committee at an agreed upon date, early Spring. The recipient(s) names and a copy of their applications are due to Community Foundation of the Ozarks by the deadline posted on the website.

**Notification of Recipient:** The recipient(s) will be recognized at his or her school's awards assembly. The recipient will receive an award letter from CFO including instructions to go to the CFO website [www.cfozarks.org](http://www.cfozarks.org) and *activate* their scholarship for payment.

**Distribution of Funds:** When required documentation is received, payment will be made to the recipient's college account. If the recipient withdraws from school, the unused funds will be returned to CFO for deposit in the scholarship fund.
