## About Unit II Part I: In this unit...



 Including his time in school on and off of the reservation.


This is similar to what happens to the characters in our books.

- Answer the following question in your journals.
- 1. Write down some of your own memorable school experiences positive or negative. Which kind of memories seem to dominate? Are the experiences connected?
- 2. What overall impression does Alexie create of life on the reservation? Point to specific EXAMPLES in the text that contribute to this impression.
- 3. The title "Indian Education" refers here to more than just formal schooling. What are some other implications of the title?
- 4. Notice those places in the essay where Alexie describes how Native Americans face prejudice and negative stereotyping. What does this focus suggest about his PURPOSE?
- 5. Alexie refers to his hair in the opening sentence of the essay and in the sections on second grade and twelfth grade. How, and of what, is his hair a SYMBOL?


#### Literature Circle Roles

- Plot Person: Fill out plot line for the story so far
- Quote Finder: Find quotes that are interesting in the story and give an explanation on why it interested you.
- Questioner: Come up high questions as you look back through the book. These will be used to help guide the discussions on Thursdays.
- Themes Analyzer: Come up with a theme/s that you think represents what you have read so far.
- Character Analyzer: Write down an characters represented in the story so far, details about them and how the author portrays them.
- Connection Person: Write down and discuss any connections you find in the story. These could be text to text, text to self, or text to world.
- Summarizer: Write a well developed summary about what has happened in the book so far.
   If you are struggling, work with the plot person/ people to make sure you are not missing any major events/ plot points.






