Shooting with Macro

What is Macro?

A setting on a digital camera that enables users to focus on subjects very close to the camera lens. (12 inches or less usually)

Macro mode is commonly used to photographing flowers, insects and other small items where you want a close-up view.

You need to select the Macro icon on your camera.










Minimum Focus Distance

The distance you can shoot in macro mode from will differ between cameras and lenses.

This is generally 12 inches or less.

Make sure that at least one part of the images is in sharp focus. It should be the area that you want to be in focus that makes the most interesting photo.



Depth of Field

You may notice that macro photograph produces a shallow depth of field.
