April means Minnesota Comprehensive Assessment (MCA) testing season. This year, April 10th will be our date for both Math (11th grade) and Reading (10th grade). Since these tests are administered online, students who are testing should remember to have their MacBook fully charged and with their charger, along with headphones.
