Exam Attendance Policy

By board policy, the following criteria must be met to be exempt from a non-EOC, non-CTE Post Assessments course.

- Students may be exempted if they have five (5) unexcused absences or less with a course average of 90 or above.

NO exemptions allowed in EOC courses and CTE Courses.

Teachers will notify students of exam exemption eligibility.

Dismissal and lunch times will vary depending on exam completion. Thank you for your patience.
