Dear Parents/Guardians,

With support of the Lockheed-Martin Corporation, the Lenape Regional High School District is offering incoming freshman the exciting opportunity to enroll in the Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Pathway to Engineering<sup>™</sup> program (*www.pltw.org*). PLTW is the leading provider of rigorous and innovative Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) education curricular programs in high schools across the United States. This program offers a dynamic curriculum where students experience real-world hands-on learning. Students create, design, build, discover, collaborate and solve problems while applying what they learn in math and science. Students will be exposed to STEM fields through professionals from local industries who supplement the real-world aspect of the curriculum through mentorships and workplace experiences.

Students are selected into this program based upon their academic achievement in math and science as well as their expressed interest in pursuing a career in engineering. The online application for the PLTW Pathway to Engineering<sup>™</sup> program will open on November 15<sup>th</sup> via the following link: <u>HTTP://www.lrhsd.org/PLTWStudentInterest</u>. The deadline for submission is December 17<sup>th</sup>. Please note that only a limited number of seats are available for PLTW during each school year. Notification of acceptance into the program will be made on or before January 14, 2022.

Your son/daughter will be administered an 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math/Science Assessment at a date to be determined by your middle school staff during the next month. The results of this test, along with the math and science grades earned in middle school will serve as the key criteria for students applying for entry in the PLTW Pathway to Engineering<sup>™</sup> program. Additionally, a careful and thorough evaluation is also made of the student's response to the questions on the online application in order to determine their level of interest and commitment to a potential four-year course of study.

We are holding an informational session on Tuesday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, at 6:00p.m., at Shawnee High School. It is highly recommended you and your student join us for this session. It will be held in the Large Group Instruction room, and staff members will be on hand to answer questions and give more information about the PLTW program.

Please be aware that acceptance into the pre-engineering program will require that your child replace one of their elective subjects each school year with the required PLTW course. Due to potential scheduling conflicts, in some cases, students will need to make the difficult decision to drop an equally valued elective course to continue enrollment in the program.
