Southside High School Summer Sports Camp Day Information

Date and Time

The gym lobby doors will open at 7:30am for check in. At this time, you will receive your schedule for the day, a map of the school/fields, and names and pictures of all coaches. All students should be off campus no later than 15 minutes after the Sports Camp Day has ended its last session. Students must stay on campus for the entire duration of the event.

Girls Day: June 19th, 2023 8am-5:15pm

Transportation

There will be a bus running to and from S.W. Snowden Elementary to aid parents with the distance from Aurora to Chocowinity. SHS will not be responsible for students who are left behind, nor are we able to provide transportation. Students who are not riding the SWS bus will be responsible for a ride to and from SHS. Activities and Sports Provided

Girls Activities Included: volleyball, basketball, track and field, soccer, softball, weightroom, and team-building competition activities

Boys Activities Included: football, soccer, basketball, track and field, baseball, wrestling, and golf.

Lunch

Your \$15 registration fee covers lunch and a small gatorade. Students will be expected to bring their own reusable water bottle and a snack if needed. If your child has any allergies or dietary needs, please make sure it is indicated on the Registration and Health Form. Students are NOT allowed to leave campus for food. If they do so, they will not be allowed to return, and their registration fee will not be refunded.

Other Information

1. Students are not allowed to leave campus during the event. If they do so, they will not be allowed to return. Southside High School, Beaufort County Schools, and other parties involved are not responsible or liable for any student who chooses to leave the property, or any injury, illness, or legal aftermath of events that happens after they have left. If a student needs a snack or other items, it will need to be dropped off to them.
2. Students are expected to participate in the activities, show good sportsmanship, and follow SHS and BCS rules. Inappropriate behavior and activities will not be tolerated and may result in removal from school property, parent pickup, and other consequences depending on the situation.
3. Rising 6th-Rising 9th graders will be required to attend sessions for all sports and activities. They are encouraged to participate, but they will not be forced to do so. If a student does not wish to participate, they may sit on the sidelines and observe. Trying new things can be difficult and sometimes stressful, so please do what you are comfortable with! High school students will be given a list of sessions for Rising 10th-Rising 12th graders and may attend the sessions they wish. If they have an open session, they may feel free to go into the weightroom, attend an FCA meeting, or help with a middle school session of a sport they play.

Southside High School Summer Sports Camp Accident Waiver and Release of Liability Form

In consideration of my child's participation in the Southside High School Summer Sports Camp Day (the "Program"), I/we, _____, parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of _____, understand and agree to the following:

- My child's participation in the Program is entirely voluntary and extracurricular. There is no penalty from Beaufort County Schools if my child does not participate in the Program.
- For the Girls Summer Sports Camp Day, activities involved include, but are not limited to: Volleyball, Basketball, Track and Field, Soccer, Softball, the weightroom, and field day team-building competition activities, such as tug-of-war. Boys Summer Sports Camp Day activities include, but are not limited to: Basketball, Track and Field, Soccer, Baseball, Wrestling, Golf, Football, and field day team-building competition activities, such as tug-of-war. These and other individual and group physical activities involve at least some risk of physical injury, permanent disability, or death. I understand the risks inherent to these activities, as well as to the risks associated with my child's proximity to others engaging in those activities, and have explained those risks to my child.
- To the fullest extent permitted by law, I agree to **waive and release** any actual or potential claims on my own behalf and on behalf of my child against the Beaufort County Schools and its governing board, individual board members, employees, and/or agents, in both their individual and official capacities, for any injury or loss arising from or related to my child's participation in the Program. This waiver and release specifically includes any injury or loss caused in whole or part by the negligence of Beaufort County Schools or its governing board, employees, and/or agents.
- To the fullest extent permitted by law, I agree to **indemnify and hold harmless** the Beaufort County Schools and its governing board, individual board members, employees, and agents, in both their individual and official capacities, from any and all legal claims or litigation brought directly by or on behalf of me and/or my child at any time for any injury or loss arising from or related to his or her participation in the Program.
- I understand and have explained to my child that he or she must comply at all times throughout the Program with any applicable laws and regulations, as well as any safety protocols and directives from BCS representatives. This specifically includes that participants attending the Southside High School Summer Sports Camp are not allowed to leave campus early. Any student who leaves campus before the end of the event will not be allowed to return, and will not receive their registration fee back. Southside High School, Beaufort County Schools, and all other parties involved are not responsible for students who choose to leave campus, or any injury, illness, or legal aftermath of doing so once off school property.
- My child is physically and mentally fit to participate safely in the Program and has completed all necessary training and safety certification requirements, if any.
- This agreement and release are given freely and voluntarily with a full understanding of my rights and responsibilities. I have read this waiver and release and fully understand its terms.

Transportation

If using the S.W. Snowden bus, please note the bus will arrive at SWS at 7AM and will leave at 7:10 AM. Due to the check in process, the bus cannot wait on late students to arrive. The bus will leave SHS 15 minutes after the end of the last session and will arrive approximately 25 minutes after departure. SHS is not responsible for students who fail to get on the bus back to Snowden within this 15 minute period, and will need to be picked up by a parent or legal guardian.

If your child is being dropped off and picked up from Southside, please note the doors open at 7:30 AM for the check in process. During this time students will receive a wristband with their group's color, their schedule for the day, and be directed to their first location. It is crucial to show up on time so that students can get the most out of their first session and relieve the anxiety of finding their correct location.

Students should not be dropped off and left unattended on campus before the gym lobby doors open at 7:30am. Students should wait in the car with their parents until this time. Southside High School is not responsible for unattended students on campus before the event starts at 7:30am.
