

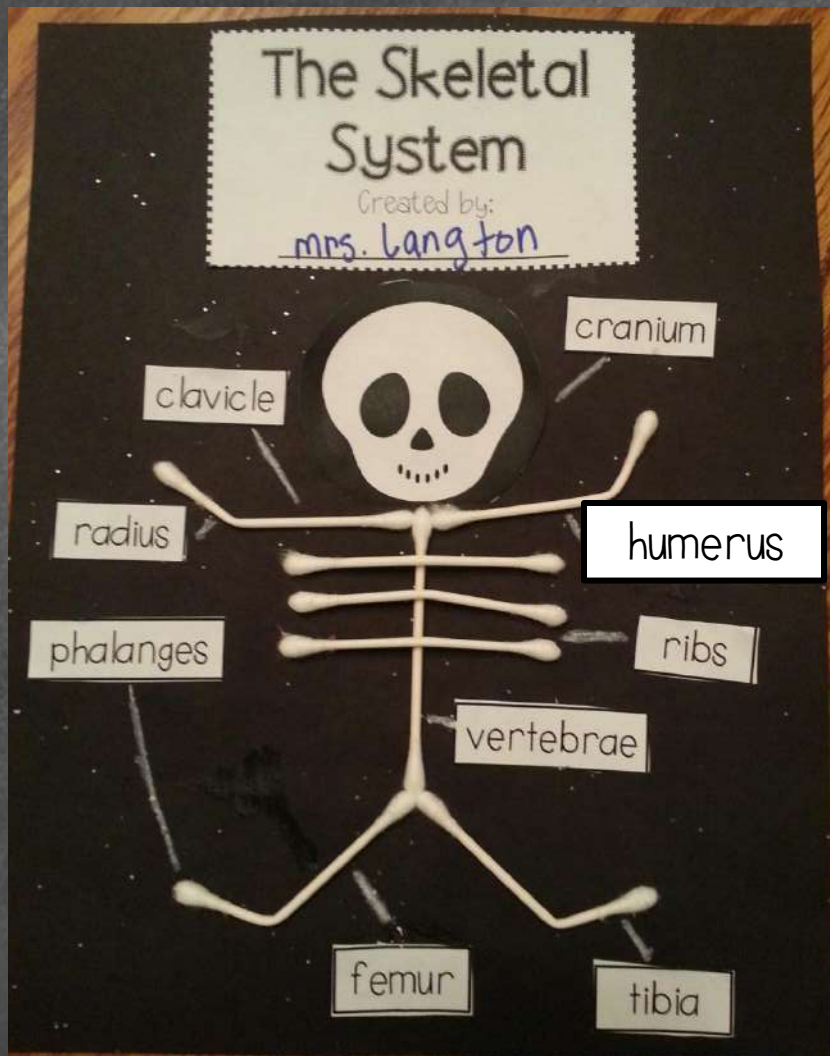
My Skeletal System!

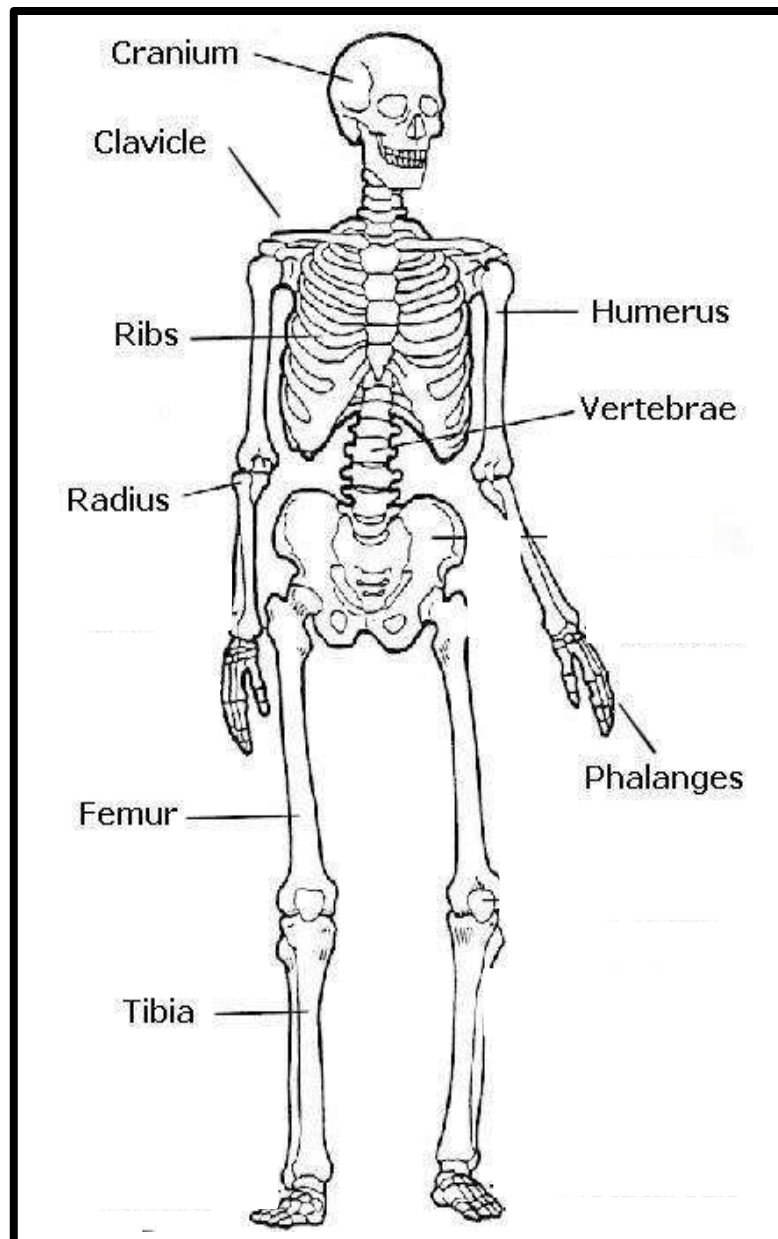
