At Ski NH we believe that winter is fun, and even more fun when days are spent outside and on the slopes or on the trails. What better way for kids to get fresh air and exercise during the colder months? There's no point in letting our children succumb to cabin fever when there is great skiing available throughout New Hampshire.



Ski NH offers a great program for 4th and 5th graders to spend more time skiing or riding this winter. Any child in 4th or 5th grade (from any state) is eligible for our [4th & 5th Grade Snowsports Passport](#). The passport includes one lift ticket or trail pass to each of our 33 member ski areas (16 downhill and 17 cross-country areas), along with additional offers at each location. One of the best parts of this program is the price. For just \$35,

4th and 5th grade children can ski up to 33 times at different ski areas throughout the state. Parents of children who have participated in this program love it because it makes skiing more affordable for the whole family, and because they get to sample different ski areas and visit new places in the state. Perhaps most importantly, passport-holding kids can't wait to use their passports and see how many ski areas they can visit.
