

### Dear SFIS Family,

It's December and Christmas songs are in every store, the weather is cold, and I hope the turkey (if you had some) was nothing short of spectacular. The last days of the semester are fast approaching and with that, the final exams stressors can be next level for our students. Please encourage them, remind them to study, and to manage their time wisely. We'll keep them as focused as we can here in Student Living.

An important reminder, the Friday academic class schedule for December allows for an early release for students at 2:00pm on the following days: December 6th and 13th. On those days the available Rail Runner times are 2:52pm and the 4:20pm southbound train departures. Please call your student's SLA or RA each week by Thursday to authorize your student(s) to ride the Friday train home. Rail Runner travel will not be available the last week of the semester (12/15-12/20), this includes mid-week requests regardless of reason. Please plan with your student accordingly.

Additionally, If you did not know, the last week of the semester (12/16-12/19) is when academics has final exams, during that time students will finish their school day early with a dismissal time of 12:40PM. The dorms will be open to accept our students at that time, and schedules have been adjusted to account for this. It should be noted that we do still hold activities and study hall for the students during that week, but we are cognizant of their testing load. We do ask that families be supportive of our students getting their study time in, considering finals can already be hard enough with preparation.

Details on the Student Living department provided Winter Travel have been shared before through various messaging and SL Staff phone calls, but please see the attached flyers for any information you may need. Be aware that this year is different than those in the past because we are only providing transportation to those communities outside the 60-mile radius from SFIS, based on the student's NASIS address. Be aware these numbers have already been confirmed and no additional adjustments can be made.

Christmas Break starts Thursday, December 19th with the end of exams at 12:40PM. We highly encourage those families that are able, especially our within 60-mile radius communities to pick-up their students for that extra day of rest and family connection. We will be sending a certain amount of those students who are taking the department provided travel that same day to get them home earlier for some restful family connection time.

Friday, December 20th is the travel day for those students who are taking the SL department provided transportation from communities that require a multi-hour drive. We do want to be aware of the sunset and do our best to not travel during that time. Departure dates and times have been attached to this letter. The dorms will reopen after the break on Tuesday, January 7th, 2025 at 4pm.

We have included the December Activity Calendar, which has everything going on at High School Student Living. Martina Valdo, MSSL Coordinator, will send a newsletter and calendar on behalf of Middle School Student Living, if it has not arrived already by this letter's publication.


