- ➤ Introductions (All)
- > SLT Chair (Ms. Forbes)

In Ms. Forbes absence, Mr. Copeland stated the goal for end of year is to have a group of 6-7 parents that are interested in being on the ballot for election to join SLT in August. Parent Advocate Keith Gayden will also begin to recruit parent volunteers for SLT.

- > Staffing (Mr. Copeland)
  - Mr. Copeland shared brief information on new teachers: Anne Merritt, gr. 1, Hannah Rumely, gr. 1. Ms. Merritt has been in her classroom for two weeks and we are excited to have her on board. Ms. Rumely's first day is today and her transition will be an ideal two weeks with the outgoing teacher Mrs. Koenig, who is relocating out of state. We are currently interviewing for Reach Associate as Mrs. Graham is leaving Allenbrook after attaining a promotion in CMS. Mr. Copeland shared information about new staff member- Parent Advocate: Keith Gayden.
- > Facilities
  - Mr. Copeland shared that we did not receive additional custodial staffing. Parent Ms. Carr shared concerns and showed three photos from her cell phone of dirt and muddy floors in her students' classrooms found in the morning. She states that classrooms are not being cleaned and not spot mopped as was shared at last month SLT's meeting. Ms. Carr went into Mrs. Bates' room and found slime and dirt on the floor on Monday morning. She stated "I don't understand how you don't see that". Mr. Fisher recommended a supervisor complete a weekly spot mop. Mr. Copeland will meet with Principal Bonasera, share SLT concerns, and will determine next steps.
- School Leadership Team Early Release Proposal Mr. Copeland distributed information about options for district early release PD days for next schools year. The SLT agreed to vote for Option 1 and Parent Ms. Carr stated "parents will have difficulty

leaving jobs early, day care issues will arise, most afternoon programs don't open until 3pm, and most students will be just left at home alone". Mr. Copeland stated he will vote for Option 1 and also include these comments on the form to submit to CMS senior staff.

- ➤ Val-ED Survey
  - o Mr. Copeland shared a brief description of the survey and the purpose of using a research based evaluation tool that measures effectiveness of principals by providing a detailed assessment of a principal's perceived performance. It is a 360 degree survey to provide comprehensive and constructive feedback to the principal. Results will be used to help Mrs. Bonasera become a better leader for her school. Surveys are anonymous and Mr. Copeland encouraged all teachers to complete the survey by Thurs Feb 12<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Schneider shared the event and the hours for parents and detailed the book collection efforts and the distribution of books and classroom activities for the night.
