Principal Update: Mr. Slattery sent out an initiative to parents and faculty to reach out to our district representatives on the potential impact of the NC Class Size Mandate. Large group of our Endhaven parents reached out to these representatives.

Responses from the representatives were:

- Bishop: he is for the class size mandate and feels CMS is not allocating their funds property to be able to afford this.
- *Stone*: he is for the class size mandate. Feels the public is not understanding the information correctly and convoluting the statistics.
- Belk: Against class size mandate

3rd Grade Field Trip: Play Content: 3rd grade booked a field trip to the Childrens Theatre to see a play about Cassius Clay. A few weeks ago, teachers discovered that the N-word was used in the play contents. Children's theatre confirmed they will not remove the word, but did send information on where and how it is used in the play. 3rd grade and Mr. Slattery sent home a letter informing parents of the use of the word to give parents a chance to discuss with their children. 3rd grade will be using a graphic organizer with the students for them to fill out before the play outlining different details and events to be aware of during the play to help them follow along and understand the contents. This will focus more on the biography aspect of the play vs the language.
