# The Project

# Skills you will be working on

- ⊙ Using the *Elements of Art & Composition* to tell your story
- ⊙ Using *Depth of Field* to visually isolate your *Focal Point*

# Project Overview

- ① **Complete Brainstorming Sheet & Plan Photos**
- ② **Shoot a minimum of 30 photos** showing your concept through at least 5 different setups
  - Test out a variety of different angles for each setup
  - Use elements & composition skills to show your concept
  - Make sure there is a Focal Point!
  - Use Shallow Depth of Field to visually isolate your main subject
- ③ **Edit your best 5 photos**
  - Images may be Color, Black & White, or a Combo
- ④ **Add photos to a Google Photo Album** titled “Last Name:Social Distancing”
