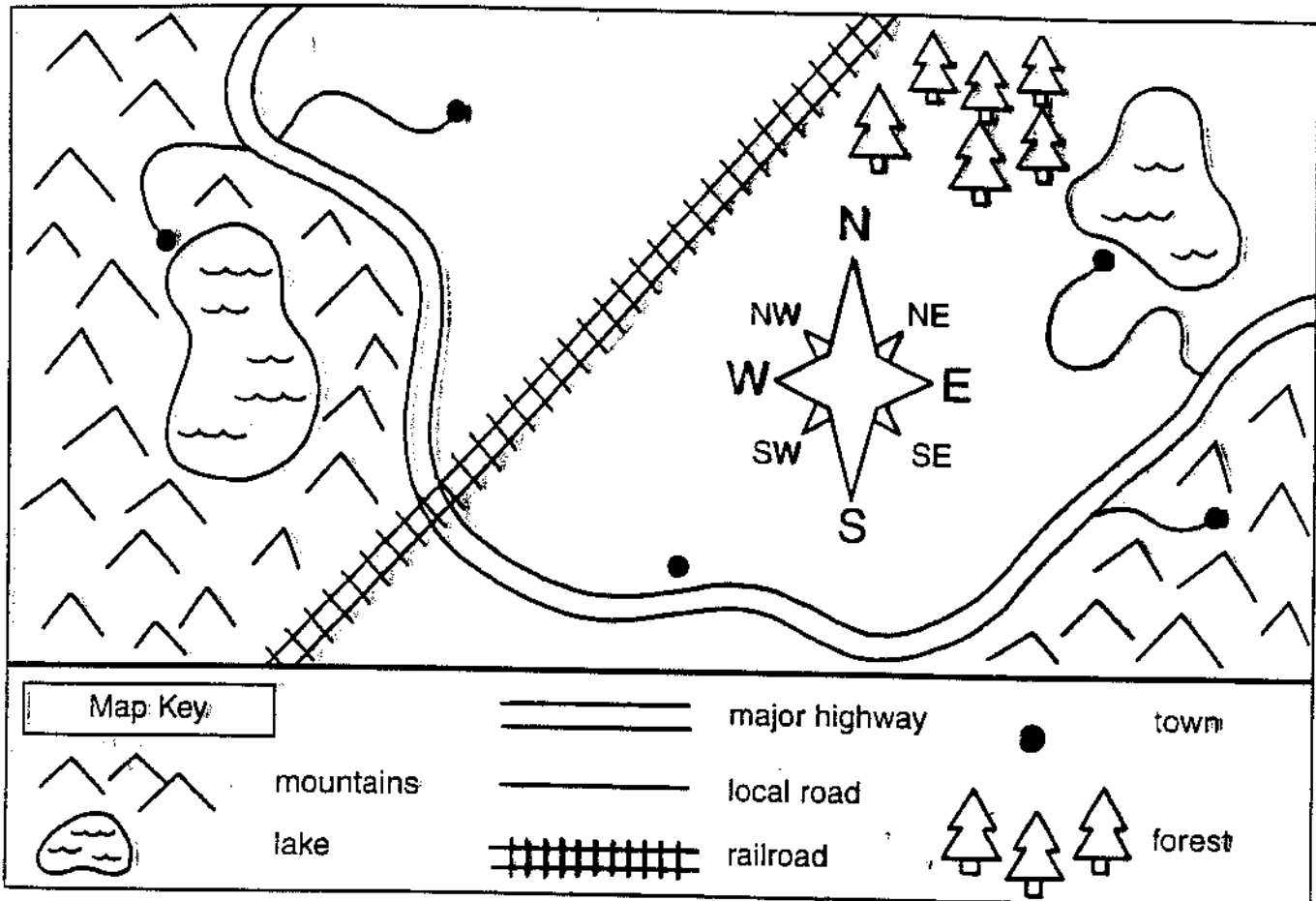


I've Got the Key!
