3. Removal of Brain



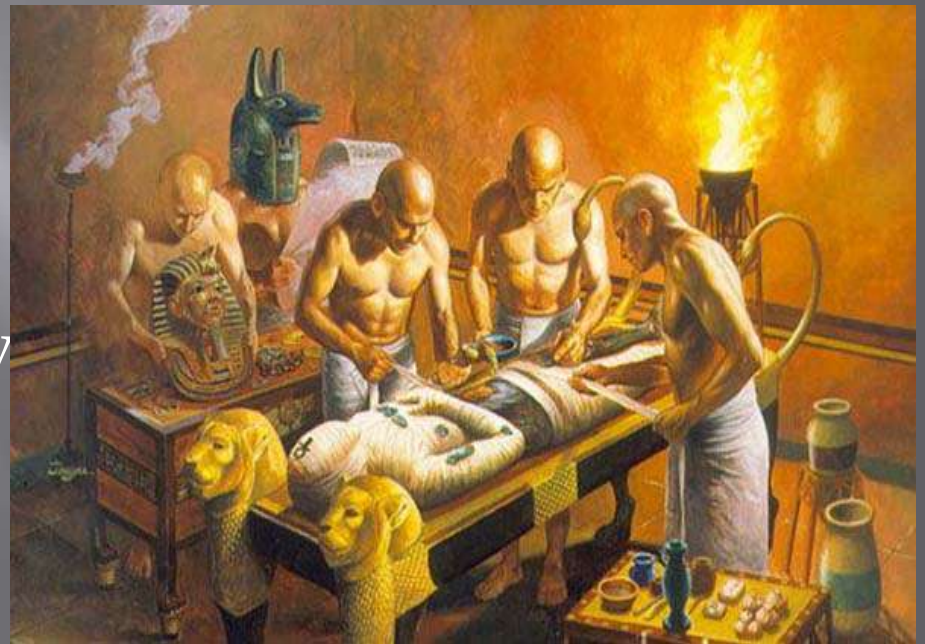
Steps of Mummification

- ▣ Wrapping of Body



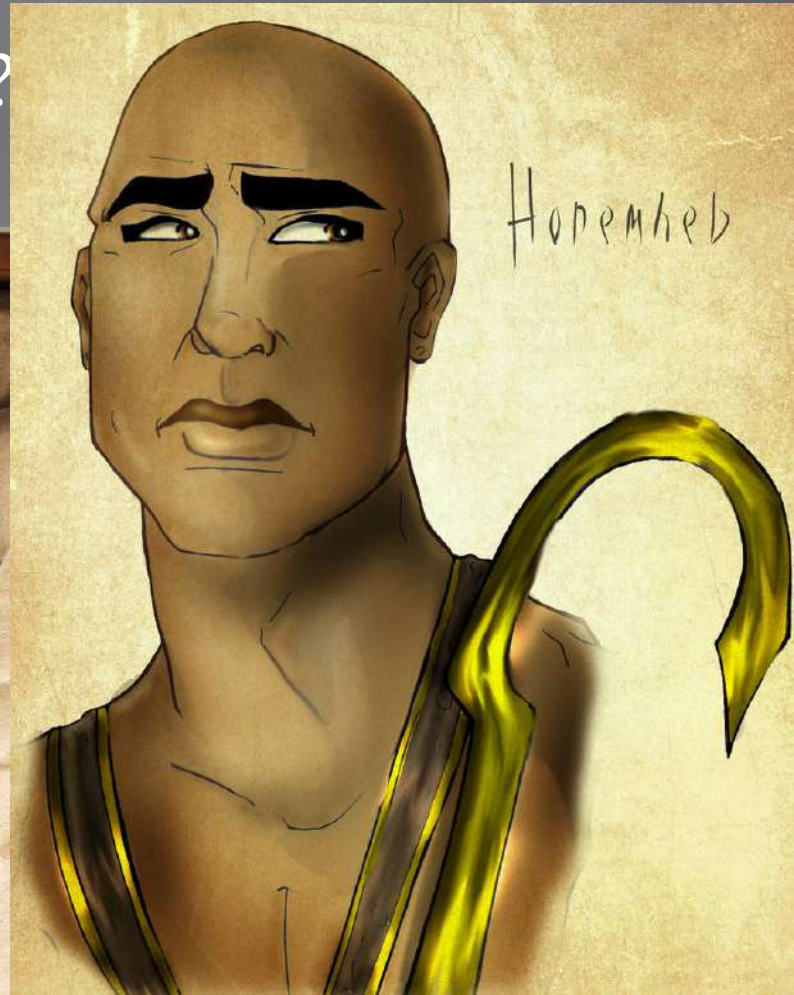
King Tutankhamun (King Tut)

- ▣ Murdered?



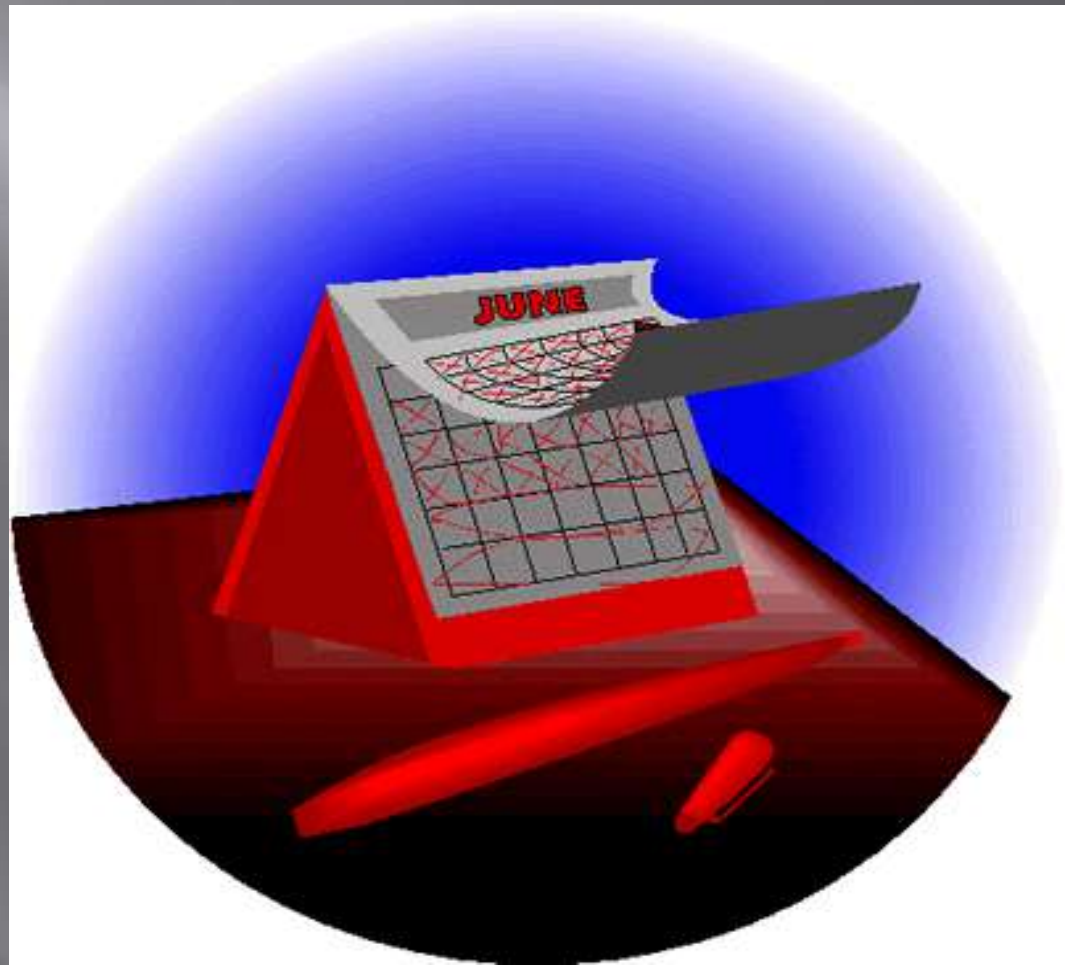
Medicine

- ▣ Complex Surgery



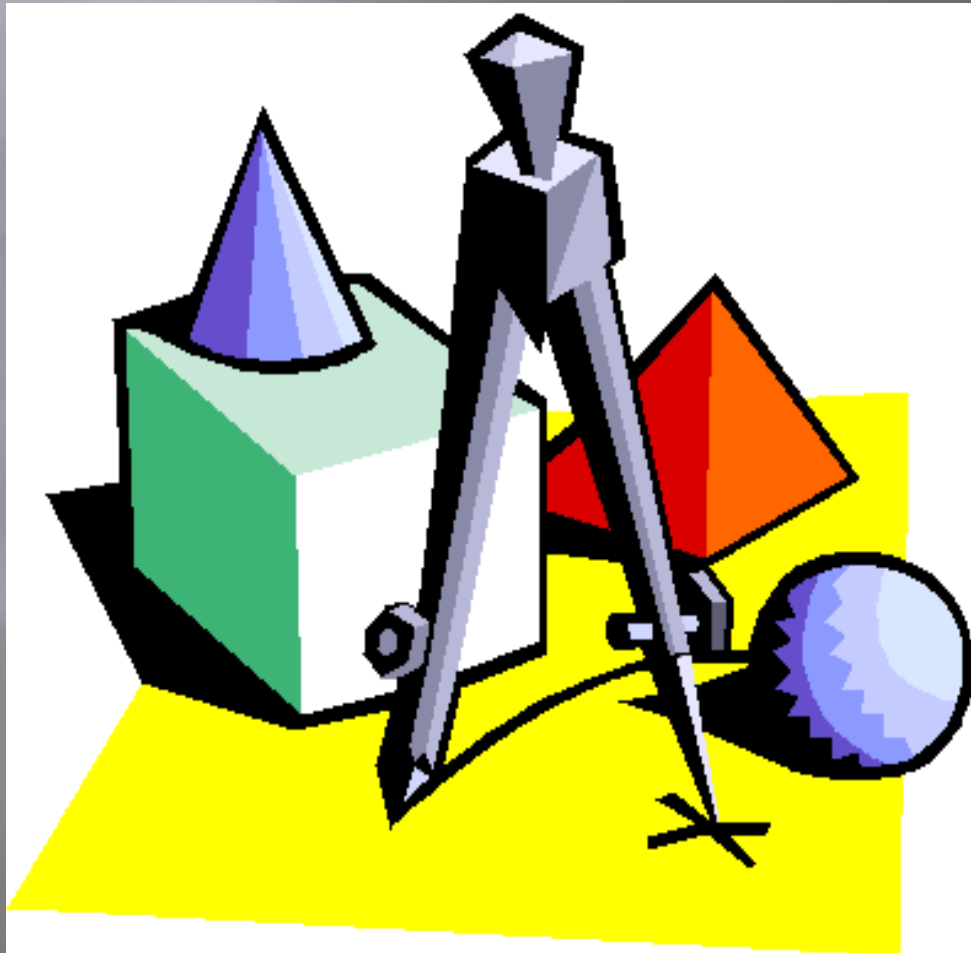
Astronomy

▣ Advances in Geometry

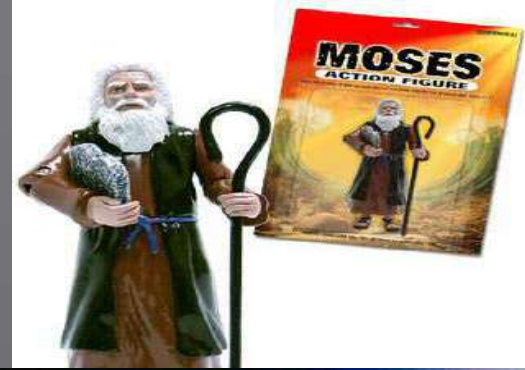


Tale of Sinhue
