- AP = Advanced Placement (open enrollment)
- CIS = College in the Schools -UofM (rank/GPA requirements)

- After you have logged into Infinite Campus
- Click on Academic Planner

- Click on an open box to select from your list of available courses
- Grayed out courses mean you are not eligible to register for the course. (See your counselor for details).
