• • Accelerated, AP, CIS

- Accelerated = placed according to test scores (placement made for you)
- AP = Advanced Placement (open enrollment)
- CIS = College in the Schools -UofM (rank/GPA requirements)

• • PSEO (Post-Secondary Education Options)

- Eligible high school students can enroll in college or university courses that earn credits simultaneously for both their high school diploma and college degree.

CAPS offers three programs:

- February 7th-16th, counselors available every day for Registration Q & A during 4th hour in the Commons.


