What's New for You?

Your Graduation Requirements

- Due to the change of our daily schedule during your senior year, 2019 grads must earn **50 total credits** in grades 9-12 in order to graduate from Shakopee High School. This is an addition of 2 elective credits because you will have a chance to earn 16 credits during your senior year as compared to 14 now.
- In addition to earning credits to graduate, students must meet or exceed credits in each of the following subject areas (See table)

Subject Area	Credits = Grades 9-12
English	8
Mathematics	6
Social Studies	8
Science	6
Fine Arts	2
Health	1
Physical Education	2
Total Electives	17
Total Credits Required:	50

The school year is divided into two semesters. A successfully completed one-semester course will earn one semester credit. Courses concurrently enrolled with a college or university will earn one high school credit for every two college/university semester credits.



Course Information

- **“Prerequisites”**
 - **Make sure you have met the requirement to take a class & that it is offered for your grade!**
 - **If you have registered for a class and don’t meet the requirements, you will be removed from the class.**
 - **For example, you need to take Theatre or Intro to Drama before you can take Acting I.**
 - **CIS courses have prerequisites.**



AP, CIS, Honors

- **AP = Advanced Placement (open enrollment)**
- **CIS = College in the Schools (rank/GPA requirements)**
- **Accelerated = Placed according to test scores (placement made for you)**

***See registration guide for specific requirements.**



What if I Fail Classes?

- **Failing one or two classes each semester will mean that you will not graduate on time.**
- **Counselors will help you make a plan for credit recovery! It is up to you to seek us out if you need help.**



Credit Recovery Options

- **Summer School**
- **After school credit recovery (APEX)**
- **Re-take the class (if there is room in your schedule)**

- **Be sure to have your signature and your parent/guardian signature.**
- **All 11th grade course options are arranged by areas of interest.**
- **Registration Forms will be checked and collected by Homeroom Teachers the week of January 17th.**
