## BIRMINGHAM PUBLIC SCHOOLS HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Birmingham Public Schools Board of Education approved adhering to the Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC), requiring 18 credits in specific courses. The number of credits required to graduate will transition from 26.5 in 2025 to 22.0 in 2028.
