## GUIDELINES FOR SOUTH FOUNTAIN PIONEERS SCHOLARSHIP (Young Farmers Organization)

### ELIGIBILITY

1. Graduates of Fountain Central High School, Covington High School and Attica High School are eligible (male or female).

2. Applicants must plan on a course of study resulting in a major in Agriculture or

3. Applicants planning a 4-year course of study or other post-secondary education (vocational school) will be considered.

### AWARDS

- 1. There will be a monetary amount awarded annually. This amount will be told
- 2. The award may be distributed as follows:

A. The full amount may be awarded to one (1) student.

B. Or the amount may be divided between two (2) or more deserving students.

3. The final number of recipients and the amounts of awards will be at the discretion of the scholarship committee.
