II. Discussion to Address Patron Comments Regarding Parity in Budget Recommendations for CPF and General Fund Expenditures

Superintendent Dr. Kimberly Tucker provided an agenda and a handout to those in attendance. The handout included: 1) a copy of the results of a teacher survey regarding perceived inequity that had been taken at Clay City Jr/Sr High School. The survey was in regard to Clay City Jr/Sr High School grounds, building, gym, staffing, technology, and miscellaneous items; 2) a chart showing comparison of elementary staffing/student ratios for 2013-14 as well as elementary student/classroom teacher ratio from 2010-11 and going forward. A chart was also provided showing high school/middle school statistics for the secondary schools; 3) information regarding the athlete to coach ratio comparing Clay City Jr/Sr High School to Northview High School and Clay City Jr High grade levels to North Clay Middle School; 4) elective offerings for 2014-15 at both Clay City Jr/Sr High School and Northview High School; 5) 2014 CPF projects for Clay Community Schools and potential future CPF projects for Clay Community Schools; 6) an article titled "Why Construction Referenda Could Lead to Inequalities in School Facilities" from the Indiana Public Media web site http://indianapublicmedia.org; and, 7) photos illustrating possible future configurations of various areas within schools, such as media centers and science labs. A copy of the handout will become a part of the official minutes.

Discussion of each item on the Clay City Jr/Sr High School survey ensued, as well as discussion of the other items included with the handout.
