Geography of Spain

LOCATION OF SPAIN

Located in the southwestern part of Europe, Spain occupies eighty percent of the Iberian peninsula, which it shares with Portugal.

SIZE AND POPULATION

Spain has an area of about 200,000 square miles (four times the size of New York State), and a population of about 40,000,000 inhabitants.

MOUNTAINS

- 1. The Pyrenees (los Pirineos), in the northeast, separate Spain from France.
- 2. Cantabrian Mountains (la Cordillera Cantábrica) in the northwest.
- 3. Guadarrama Mountains (la Sierra de Guadarrama), near Madrid.
- Sierra Nevada and Sierra Morena, in the south.

RIVERS

- 1. El Ebro, in the northeast, flows into the Mediterranean Sea.
- 2. El Tajo, in the central region, is the longest river. It runs by the city of Toledo.
- 3. El Guadalquivir in the south, is the deepest and most navigable river in Spain. It runs by the cities of Seville (Sevilla) and Cordova (Córdoba).

OVERSEAS POSSESSIONS

- The Balearic Islands (Islas Baleares) are located in the Mediterranean Sea. They are a popular resort area. Mallorca is the largest island in the group.
- 2. The Canary Islands (Islas Canarias) are located in the Atlantic Ocean, off the northwestern coast of Africa.
- 3. Ceuta and Melilla are two port cities in Morocco, Africa.

IMPORTANT PRODUCTS

- Spain is both an industrial and an agricultural country.
- 2. The principal agricultural products are olives, oranges, grapes, wheat, lemons, and cork.

Spain is divided into fifteen regions.

Cantabria, in the north

Galicia, in the northwest

Asturias, in the north, east of Galicia

Basque Country (País Vasco), in the north, bordering the Pyrenees

Navarre (Navarra), in the north

Aragon (Aragón), in the northeast, east of Navarra Catalonia (Cataluña), in the northeastern corner Rioja (La Rioja), south of Navarra

Castile and Leon (Castilla y León), in the north central part of the peninsula

Castile-La Mancha (Castilla-La Mancha), in the

Madrid, in the center, north of Castile-La Mancha Valencia, in the east

Extremadura, in the west, between Portugal and Castile-La Mancha

Andalusia (Andalucía), in the south

LANGUAGES

- 1. Spanish (español, or castellano) is the principal language spoken in Spain.
- 2. Galician (gallego) is spoken in Galicia.
