The School Board, having accepted the description of an appropriate negotiating unit, has on file a dated petition from the East Central Education Association, which contends that it represents a majority of teachers within the negotiating unit. This notice, which is posted in every school in the unit, announces that the Board will meet on February 28, 2023 to consider the petition and to determine the question of representation.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 15.1-16-10 and 15.1-16-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, the School Board of East Central Center for Exceptional Children (hereafter "Board") recognizes all certified teachers employed by the board (excluding Director) as the appropriate negotiating unit for the 2022-2023 negotiated agreement.

The Board further determines that East Central Education Association represents a majority of the persons within the above appropriate negotiating unit, and it therefore recognizes East Central Education Association as the representative organization of that unit for the 2022-2023 negotiated agreement.
