Speech #6: Group Speech Assignment

### Directions:

Each member needs to go to Ted.com and watch a speech. Choose a talk that strikes your interest and that you think could strike your classes interest, but is different than everyone else in your group. Please sign up your talk with the sub BEFORE you start watching it, to make sure that someone else hasn't already chosen it. Your talk should be at least 10 minutes but not more than 18 minutes in length. After you watch your speech, write a 2-3 page typed reflection evaluating the speaker. This should include a brief summary of the main message of the speech as well as:

- Why do you think this person chose to speak about the topic?
- What was the speaker's purpose of their speech, how do they want the audience to respond?
- What are the local, national or global implications of the topic being spoken about?
- What elements of the speech did you enjoy most? [Delivery, organization, the attention-getter...?].
- Was there anything you think the speaker could have improved on?

Your reflection will be due on Monday and make sure you mention the speaker and title of the talk in your reflection.

Next, you will come together in your group on Monday and share the speeches you viewed with the rest of the group. You do not need to all watch all the speeches but may want to and it could prove helpful. As a group you need to pick one speech (Which you all should watch) that you are going to introduce to the class. Please pick a speech you think holds something important for us to see and hear (great speaking, interesting topic, important information, knowledge everyone should be aware and etc).

On the Tuesday, you will be presenting this speech to the rest of the class. The purpose of your group presentation will be to introduce us all to a speech and then have us watch it. I will need a copy of your typed group outline. This will be a group presentation and should include the following parts on the back. All group members should speak and each person should speak about the same amount of time. Your group speech should be about 4-8 minutes longer than your talk you will be playing. If your talk is 15 minutes, than your group speech should be 19-23 minutes long.

- A. Intro the Speaker / Speech
- B. Who is the intended audience and what is the speaker's purpose?
- C. Play the speech
- D. Explain significance of speech topic and why you picked this speech for us to view.
- E. Evaluate the speaker elements of the speech and give them at least one suggestion to improve the speech

# III. Conclusion

- A. Restate your Purpose Statement
- B. Summarize your main points in order they were discussed and by whom
- C. Provide a final clincher to end your speech with a bang!
