

Spelling Activities for Spelling Practice

- Write each word 2 times.
- Write the list words in ABC order.
- Choose 10 words. Write them and add up their sums using the following scale:
A=1, B=2, C=3, D=4, E=5, F=6, G=7, H=8, I=9, J=10, K=11, L=12, M=13, N=14, O=15, P=16, Q=17, R=18, S=19, T=10, U=21, V=22, W=23, X=24, Y=25, Z=26
- Choose 5 spelling words from the list and write 2 rhyming words for each word you chose.
- Have an adult say the word and you write it!! (in your best penmanship).
- Choose 4 spelling words. Choose one of the four types of sentences and write one sentence for each word.
- **Sentence Choices:** STATEMENT (gives information), QUESTION (asking), EXCLAMATION (shows greater feeling), and COMMAND (gives direction or expectation). QUESTIONS end with question marks (?), EXCLAMATIONS end with an exclamation mark (!) STATEMENTS end with periods (.) COMMANDS can end in either a period (.) or an exclamation mark (!).

For Example:

- Choose a spelling word from the weekly list → Pumpkin
- Choose a question for your type of sentence.
- Write the word in the question format.
- Do you like pumpkin pie with vanilla ice cream and cinnamon?

Look carefully. Every sentence begins with a capital letter (uppercase) and ends with a period, exclamation mark, or question mark.
